

# Arta S.r.l. embodies the construction of the future: innovative, environmentally conscious, and employing efficient solutions. With Arta, urban regeneration reaches new standards.

Arta S.r.l. has started approximately 58 construction projects in the last three years, employing 320 people and working with 43 subcontractors. It has seen a 715% increase in turnover over the last three years, with 18 new construction projects underway and projects already underway to be completed by 2024.

It has successfully incorporated innovative techniques into the design and construction of its projects and adopted multiple sustainable solutions. These include the use of recyclable materials that reduce the carbon footprint of buildings; passive design, which includes the application of thermal insulation to optimize energy efficiency in both heating and cooling; and the installation of energy-efficient windows. Another key element of Arta S.r.l.'s construction philosophy is: and renewable energy: the company integrates photovoltaic panels into its projects, enabling buildings to generate clean energy and, in some cases, become self-sufficient or even net energy producers. It also installs home automation systems that allow control of electrical and heating systems transforming

buildings into true “smart homes.” The company makes extensive use of ventilated walls combined with traditional thermal insulation, further improving thermal comfort, and adopts fiber-reinforced materials (FRP) already successfully used for structural reinforcement in earthquake-prone areas. Of great importance, too, is the use of heat pumps in combination with photovoltaic systems, which sees Arta S.r.l. already comply with the EU directive banning condensing boilers powered by fossil fuels by 2040. Such a strong propensity for innovation has allowed Arta S.r.l. to develop highly specialized know-how, which has enabled it to

expand effectively on international markets and to already operate in full harmony with the EU Directive on green homes 2030. Thanks to the collaborative and proactive approach in the search for reliable economic and financial partners, moreover, no Superbonus 110 project managed by Arta S.r.l.
